

## **Instructions Application to Conduct A M14RA Sanctioned Match or clinic**

A M14RA sanctioned match is an event hosted or sponsored by a M14RA Member or Affiliate Member whereby sponsors agree to use M14RA “Approved” Competition Rules in conducting their event. Please read these instructions thoroughly prior to completing the application. ### **REQUIREMENTS FOR MATCH SPONSORS**

1. Be a current member or affiliate member of the M14RA in good standing.
2. Pay a \$35 fee to the M14RA for each sponsored event. Sponsors may charge individual entry fees to match participants to cover their expenses in conducting the match. These entry fees are to be paid to the match sponsor and are retained by the match sponsor.
3. Attach a copy of a match program with the application when it is submitted. A program is a written description of the event to include the following: description of the event, date, location, time, schedule and course of fire, entry fees, etc..
4. Conduct the match in accordance with “Approved” current Competition Rules. A list of “Approved” Competition Rules are posted on the M14RA Match page on the M14RA website at [www.M14RA.org](http://www.M14RA.org).
5. Provide qualified range officers, line officers and other officials, targets and other supplies as required in order to conduct a match safely. It is highly recommended that a ratio of no more than one line official per a maximum of five shooters is maintained. Allowances for coaching is encouraged, but not mandatory.
6. Obtain and retain on file a notarized Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement for all match participants. A copy of the Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement may be downloaded from [m14rifleassoc@gmail.com](mailto:m14rifleassoc@gmail.com)
7. on the M14RA Match page on our website.
8. Submit a notarized Sponsor Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement with the application.
9. Submit at M14RA Sanctioned Match Report and the scorecards of all competitors who fired in any sanctioned match, less the tear-off portions of the score cards to the M14RA within seven days after the match.

**Note: Hearing and Eye Protection as well as the use of ECIs (Empty Chamber Indicators) is mandatory at all M14RA Sanctioned Shooting Events or Clinics.**

M14RA Support For a Sanctioned Match. To support your organization's conducting of the match, the M14RA will:

1. Recognize the match as an event that is Officially Sanctioned by the M14RA
2. Post information about your match in the upcoming events section on the M14RA website. This is to help other interested shooters find out about matches that they might wish to attend.
3. Provide a pdf file download of M14RA approved scorecards for use in M14RA Sanctioned Matches.
4. Make available for purchase, ECIs or Empty Chamber Indicators by the match sponsor.
5. Use of ECIs in all M14RA matches is required.

## **Completing the Application Form**

The information below is given to provide a explanation for items that must be completed in the application form.

- M14RA Member or Affiliate Member number. All M14RA members that apply for a M14RA sanctioned match, must be a current member in good standing. Additionally, shooting clubs, state associations or other organizations that apply for a M14RA sanctioned match, must be a current affiliate member of the M14RA in good standing.
- Type of Event. Be sure to describe in full, the type of event planned.
- Type of Rifles. Please list all rifles that you are allowing to shoot in the match.
- Dates. List the exact date(s) on which the match will take place.
- Location. Give the name of the city and zip code.
- Course of Fire. List match name if applicable and number of shots for record.
- Match Contact Person. Your application must list the name and contact information of the person match competitors can contact to obtain information or register. Include name, phone number and e-mail address.
- Club website. If your club or organization has a website, be sure to provide the web address.
- ECI's (Empty Chamber Indicators). Use of ECIs are required at all M14RA sanctioned shooting events. Please fill in quantity desired.
